Dr. Wright is an international speaker, a consultant in family therapy and family nursing, a renowned Clinician and Professor Emeritus of Nursing, University of Calgary, Calgary, Canada. Dr. Wright was the Director, Family Nursing Unit, University of Calgary for 20 years, a unique clinical and research unit for couples/families suffering with serious illness. Dr. Wright has been awarded doctorates by the University of Montreal, Canada, in 2008, and by Linnaeus University, Sweden, in 2012. presentations, she offers her 45 years of clinical practice experience plus her practice - based research of how best to assist families to soften their illness suffering without judgement. Dr. Wright will enlighten us about Curious Compassion that will provide ways to help clients when experiencing serious illness or end-of-life options and how to promote family healing.

The Hospice at Glengarda provides a warm and welcoming place for us and our family members to walk through life's final journey. It was built by the community to serve

the people of Saskatoon and surrounding areas. Our care is for the whole person: physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, and social. The interdisciplinary team includes nurses, physicians, care aides, social worker, support staff and holistic care, including spiritual care, music therapy, arts and recreation therapy. The hospice is designed for adults requiring end-of-life care in the last two to three months of progressive illness or disease, focused on meticulous, holistic comfort care.
